- 12 Digital AADHAAR linked lifelong learning ID for
students.**
- Validation of student's details (Name,
DOB etc.) as per AADHAAR Card**

- Physical presence of parents are required while submitting consent forms at schools
- **A confirmation SMS will be delivered to the parents through their registered mobile number updated in UDISE+**

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- Important academic documents (under identification) to be made available on DigiLocker

- Ensure printing of APAAAR ID in all Student ID Cards and other documents

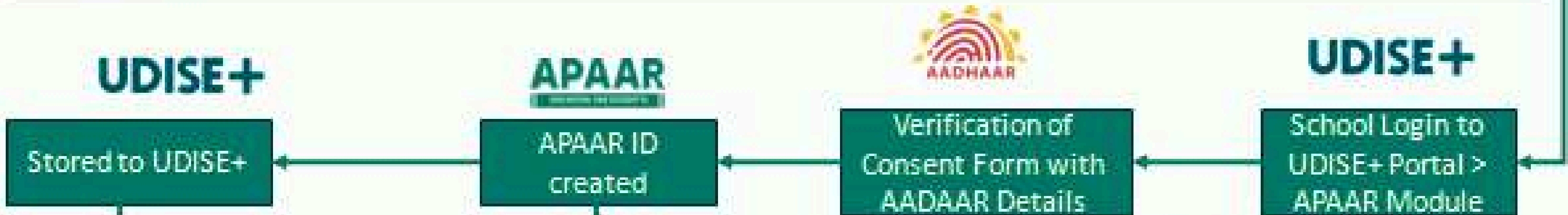

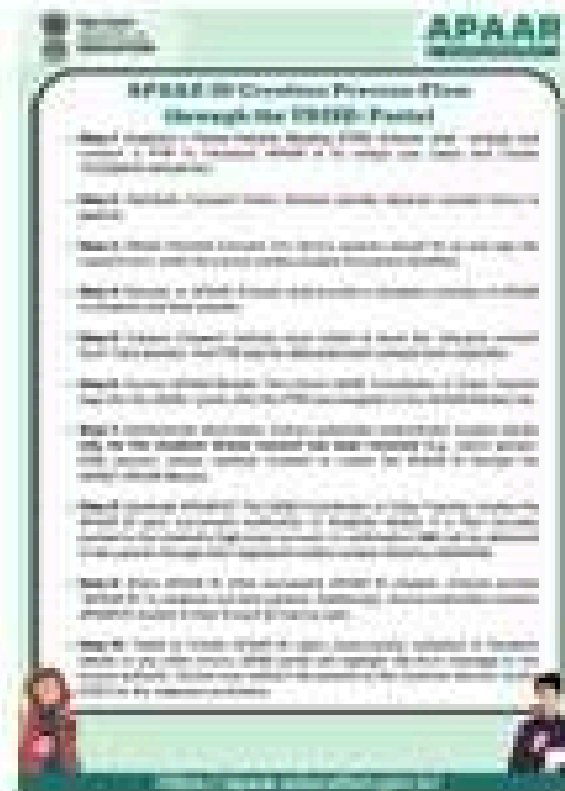


Step-By-Step Creation Process Flow

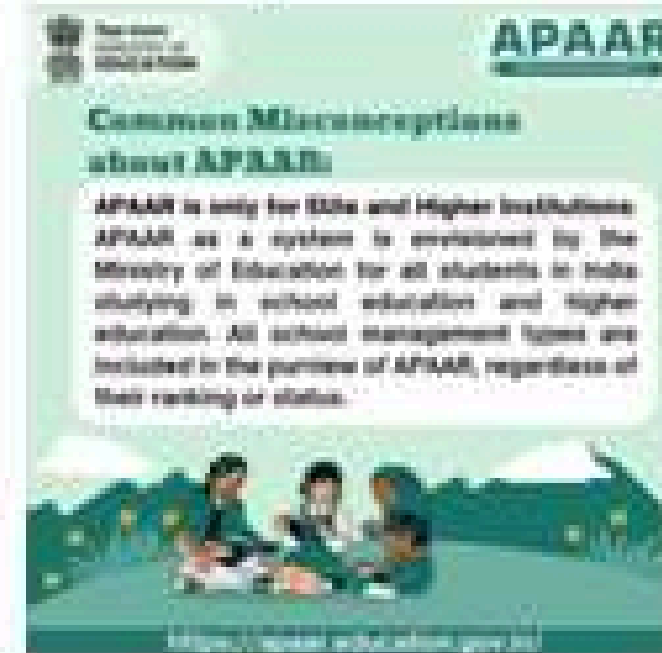

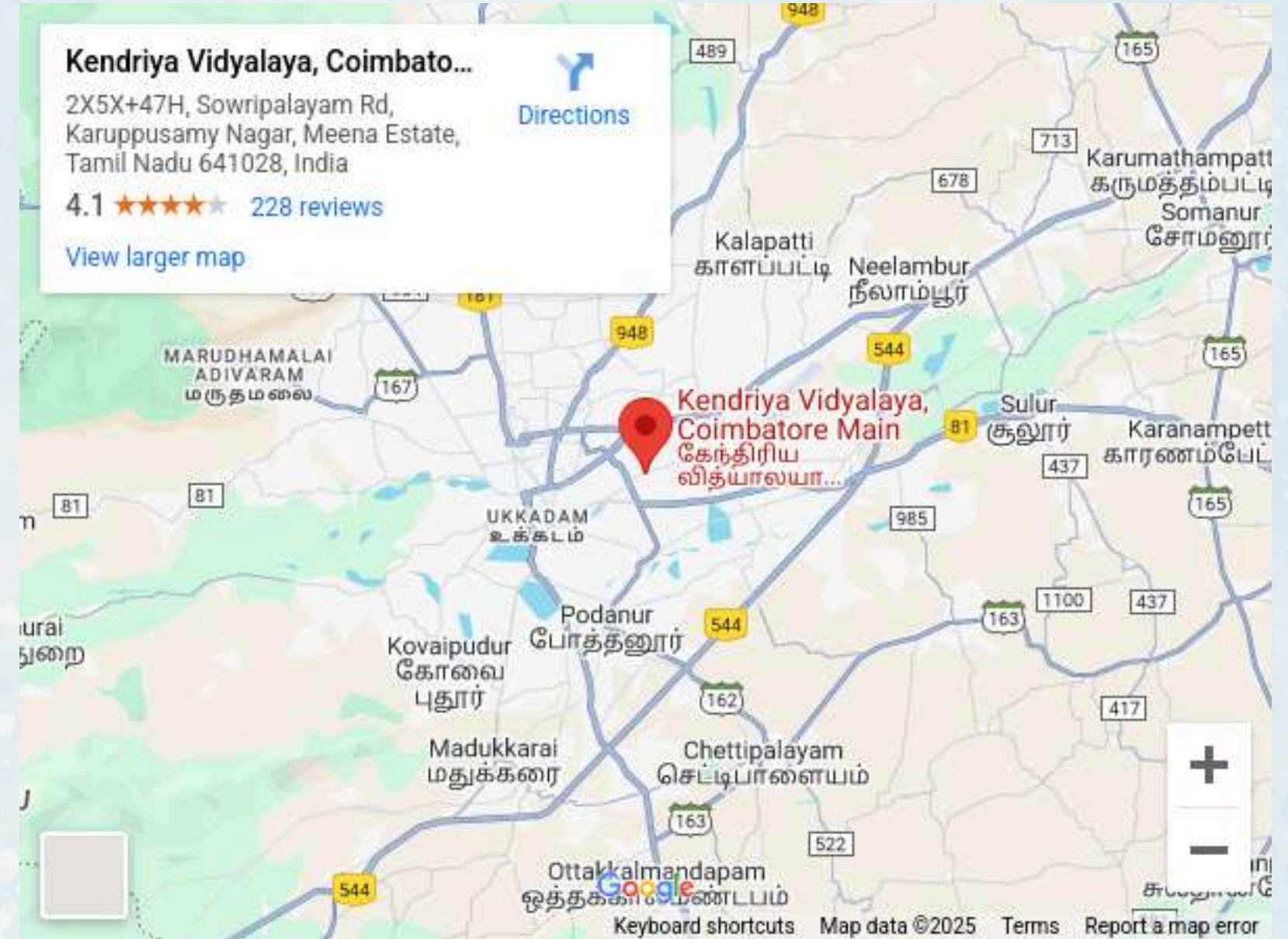
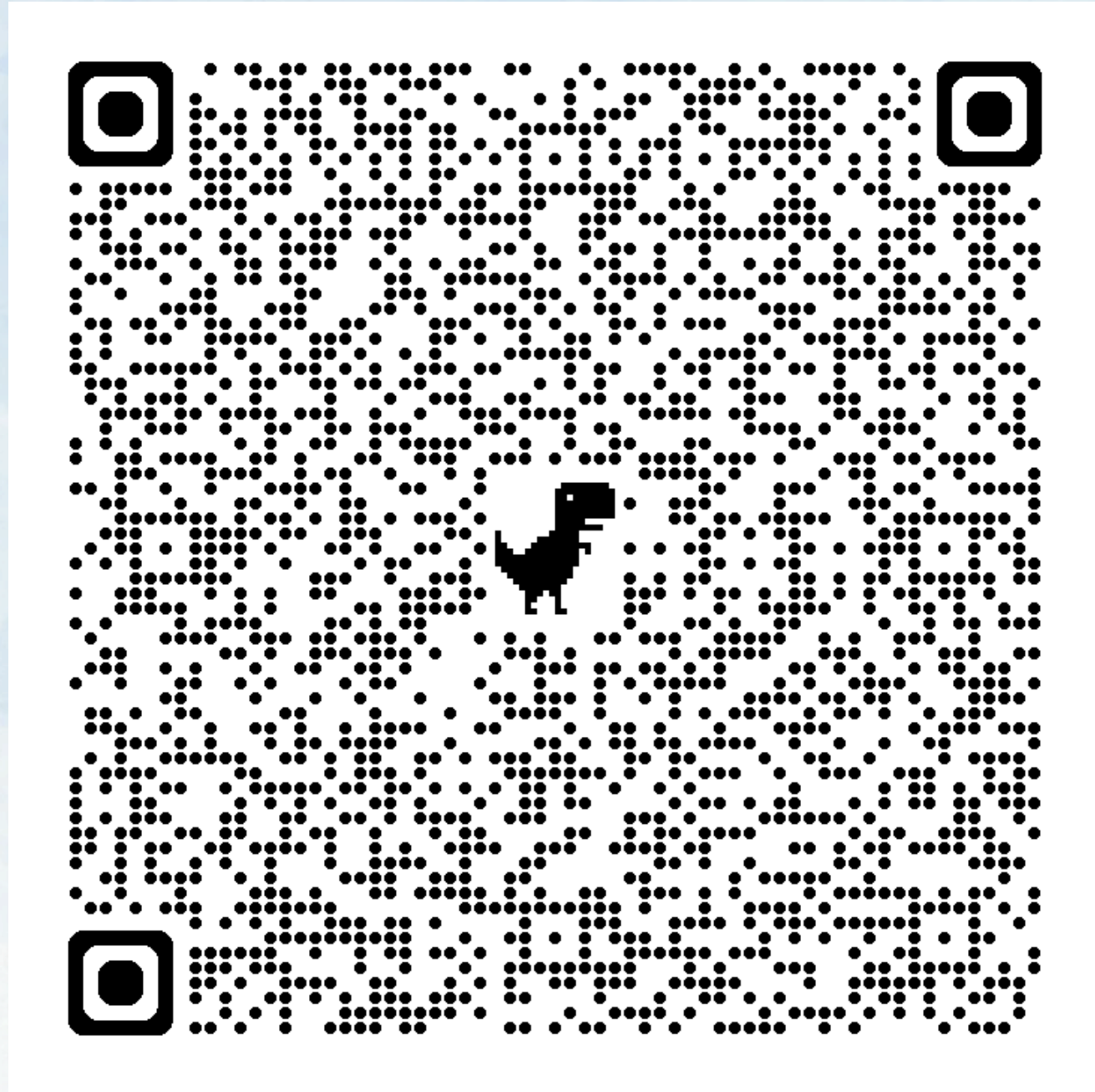

List of Permitted Items for Examination hall

- **Admit Card & School Identity Card (Mandatory)**
- **Stationery items: Transparent pouch, Geometry/Pencil box, Blue/Royal Blue ink/ballpoint/gel pen, Scale, Writing pad, Eraser**
- **Transparent water bottle**

List of Barred Items

Students are strictly prohibited from bringing the following items into the examination halls:

- Stationery items such as textual material (printed or written), pens, calculators, log tables, electronic pens/scanners, etc.
- Any communication devices including mobile phones, Bluetooth, earphones, microphones, pagers, smart watches, and cameras
- Personal items such as wallets, sunglasses, handbags, pouches, and any eatables (except for diabetic students)
- Any items that could be used for unfair means.

- **Students who possess any barred items will face penalties per the UFM rules.**
- **The examination hall is under CCTV Surveillance, a special invigilator will watch the camera to monitor the Unfair means**
- **Students attempting to manipulate the examination process by sharing exam-related materials on social media or seeking unfair advantages from examination authorities will face strict penalties. These actions are classified as serious malpractice and may result in a three-year ban from all CBSE exams.**

- **Regarding uniform updates ERP with Google Form has been shared to place orders. In between academic year, uniform requirements will not be considered.**
- **Make sure to clear all dues before receiving the admit card.**
