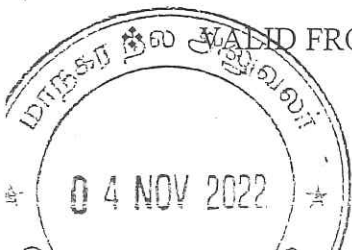

- ❖ The certificate issued is liable to be cancelled at any time on infringement of any of the above said conditions and for improper maintenances of sanitation, improper maintenance of the building as well as urinals and toilets in the building.
- ❖ Adequate fire safety precautions should be made and NOC should be obtained from Fire and Rescue Department.
- ❖ Safe and protected drinking water alone should be supplied to the children for consumption.
- ❖ The premises should be inspected periodically for mosquito breeding places and all measures should be taken to keep the premises mosquito free.
- ❖ For running a food establishment / canteen, permission should be obtained from the food safety department.
- ❖ The lab in charge should be well trained in handling the fire extinguisher.
- ❖ 'No Smoking' board should be displayed at prominent places with in the premises.
- ❖ No account sale of tobacco products should be permitted within the premises.
- ❖ Any occurrence of communicable disease should be notified to the Public Health Department.
- ❖ Necessary building plan approval should be obtained from concerned department to run the Hostel.
- ❖ All the staffs must be vaccinated with the two doses of COVID-19 vaccine and should be follow up Tamilnadu government standard operating Procedure (SOP)
- ❖ Valid for One Year Only.
